

I-84 CORRIDOR



The Idaho Transportation Department is making improvements to Interstate 84 between the Karcher Interchange and Franklin Boulevard Interchange in Nampa. The improvements are expected to improve safety, address congestion and benefit the regional economy for many years.

KARCHER ROAD OVERPASS

As part of the project, ITD is replacing the Karcher Road Overpass. The Karcher Road Overpass was built in 1966 to accommodate two lanes of I-84 in both directions. Replacing the overpass will allow additional lanes to be built on I-84. Construction will begin in March 2019 and will be complete later this fall.

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- One lane in each direction on the overpass.
- Wider shoulders.
- Sidewalk on the north side of the overpass.

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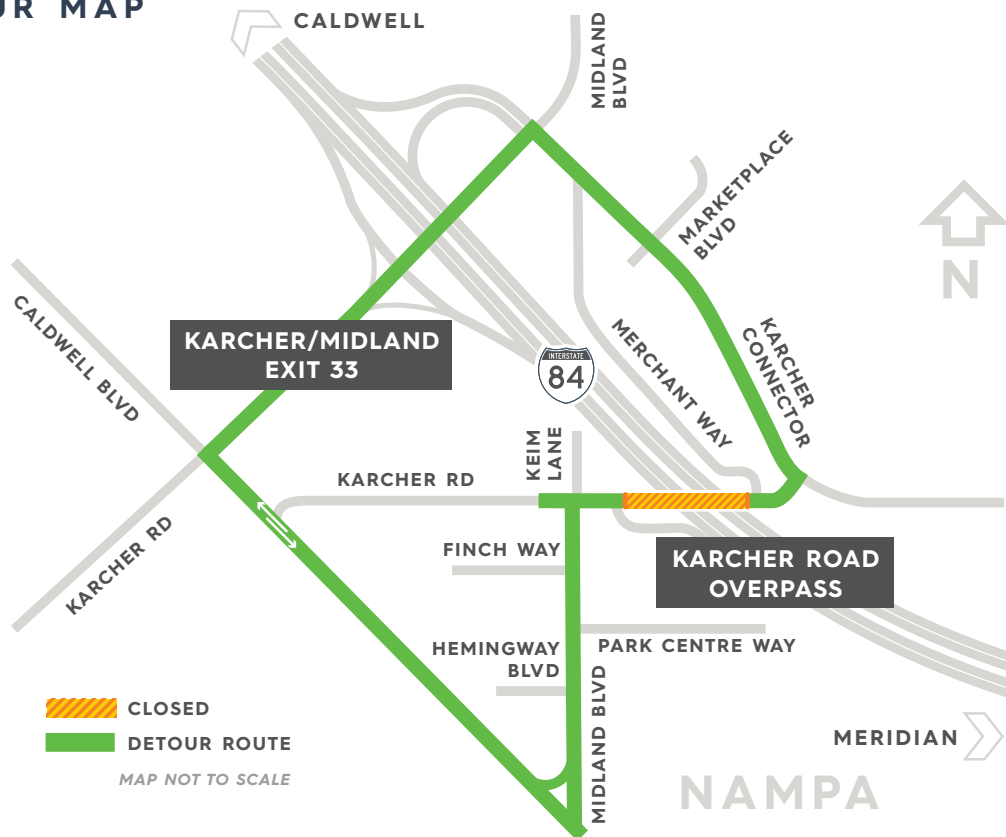

KARCHER ROAD OVERPASS

CONSTRUCTION:

ITD will close the Karcher Road Overpass during construction. Construction is anticipated to take approximately nine months to complete. ITD will detour motorists around the construction.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- The overpass will be closed and a detour will be in place.
- Business access will remain open during normal business hours.
- Work may be noisy at night due to back-up alarms and large equipment.
- Occasional I-84 detours will occur for bridge demolition and girder placement.
- Construction work may cause dust and debris.
