

US-12 AND 21ST STREET IMPROVEMENTS: CONSTRUCTION PLANS

January 2019

General information and detours

Crews will typically be on site throughout the week during the day. Work is allowed on weekends, and some work will take place at night to minimize impacts to drivers.

During construction, the following detours will be in place:


- East of the intersection, drivers may use either 24th Street to go south on 21st Street or 26th Street to go east on US-12. During construction, both streets will be converted to one-way, two-lane streets.
- West of the intersection, drivers may use 18th and Idaho streets to head north on 21st Street.

Through traffic on US-12 will not be detoured but will be reduced to one lane in each direction. A temporary signal will be installed at East Main Street and the highway to allow drivers to directly travel east on US-12 or Main Street. Detour drawings are available at the project website.

Long-distance drivers may avoid the intersection entirely by using WA-128 and the Red Wolf Bridge in Clarkston.

Phasing

Construction will occur in three phases, with work focused in each phase on areas highlighted in red.




Phase 1: intersection reconstruction

Most of 21st Street will be rebuilt in this phase, with work concentrated on the heart of the intersection.

Stormwater improvements for the city of Lewiston will be added and require some nighttime construction and short closures of Locomotive Park.

During this phase, G Street will be turned into a culdesac.

Estimated duration: five months




Phase 2: highway reconstruction

The intersection will remain closed to allow work on US-12 heading north and 21st Street near Idaho Street and 7th Avenue.

The park will also be reduced on its southern edge to the highway to create room for equipment staging as well as final improvements.

Estimated duration: one month



Phase 3: highway reconstruction

The section of highway near the Clearwater Memorial Bridge will be reconstructed.

Estimated duration: one month

Once construction starts, impacts to drivers will remain relatively consistent. Work is expected from March to October. For updates during construction, visit the project website at itdprojects.org.
