The Idaho Transportation Department is making plans to improve two interchanges on US-20 in Rexburg. The interchanges are located at University Boulevard and at SH-33.

OVERVIEW

US-20 is the main transportation corridor for Rexburg and much of northeast Idaho. As this area continues to grow, traffic and delay times are expected to increase.

In 2014, a group of local agencies and organizations began working with ITD to identify future travel needs in Madison County. The process showed that delays at two interchanges (US-20/University and US-20/SH-33) would reach unacceptable levels in future years.

The Idaho Transportation Department is designing improvements for both interchanges. Improvements are anticipated to be constructed as early as 2023.

PLANNING IMPROVEMENTS

ITD has been working with the city of Rexburg, Madison County and BYU Idaho to evaluate and design possible improvements for both interchanges. The new design will:

- Increase safety by improving traffic flow.
- Reduce delay times between now and 2045.
- Be financially feasible.

Members of the community will be invited to public meetings throughout the project to give input. Public meetings will be held online at itdprojects.org/US20Rexburg.
